# DIRECTOR ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

## **Competencies**

The Williamstown Football Club Strategic Plan is based on six key pillars of operation:

1. Management & Governance
2. Football
3. Finance
4. Marketing and Communications
5. Community
6. Facilities

A nominee must be able to display an appropriate level of experience and skill set in at least one of these key areas to be considered for a director position.

The nominee is required to submit (together with the Nomination form) a letter that rates and articulates their competencies in each of these key areas. The rating measure used to evaluate the nominee in each area is :

- Little or no experience / skillsets
- Some experience / skillsets
- Component
- Expert

## **Interview with Independent Nominations Committee**

In accordance with Cl 12.3(b)(vi) of the Club Constitution, a nominee must be available to attend an interview with members of the Independent Nominations Committee (INC) during business hours within 14 days of the date of request (or such longer time as the INC may determine in its absolute discretion).

## **VCGLR Approval as a Director of a Licensee**

Whilst the Club continues to hold a license for a gaming venue, each board member is required to be approved by the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor (VCGLR) as a Director of a licensee, in order to fulfil their role as a director of the Club.

In order to satisfy the requirements of the VCGLR, a Club Director must provide a police reference check, credit agency and answer questions about any criminal history.
